UPDATE ON CHURCH REOPENING

Unfortunately at this time, Saint Sebastian's cannot reopen due to the structural damage the church has sustained and the ongoing works.

All previous restrictions will still remain in place (booking a place for Mass, social distancing, wearing of face masks, etc.). There will also remain a restriction on numbers allowed to attend Mass, but we are able to accommodate more people within our church.

Funeral services will be celebrated within the church, but requiem Masses will not be celebrated at this time. **Please remember there is a maximum number of 30 people allowed to attend a funeral, and this number is set by the government.**

From Monday 15th March, Mass timetable will be:

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, & Friday – Mass at 10:00

Saturday – Mass at 16:30

Sunday – Masses at 09:30 & 11:00.

If you are at clinical risk of COVID-19, or have been told to shield, please follow the medical advice, and stay at home.
