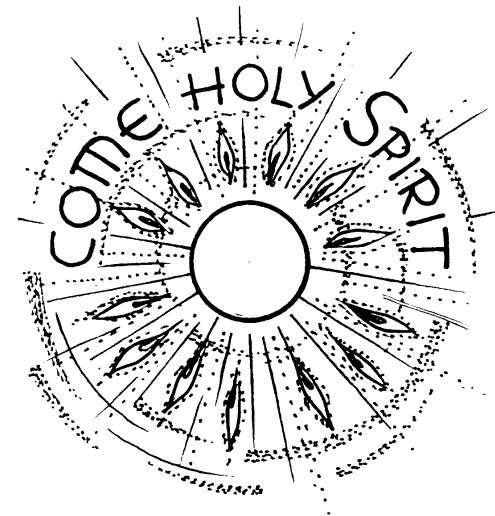

AN ECUMENICAL CELEBRATION

Pentecost 2024 marks 100 years of Liverpool's Anglican Cathedral. The theme of the celebrations will centre around how to bring us from being a group of disparate people to people who are working together. The event will take place on Sunday 19th May 2024, starting at the Metropolitan Cathedral of Christ the King at 3pm, and move on to Liverpool Cathedral, where a speaker will give an address.
