

LUCKY NUMBER LOTTERY

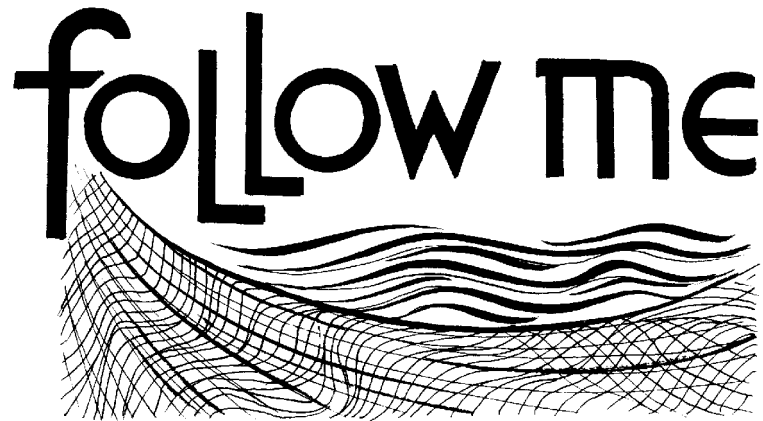

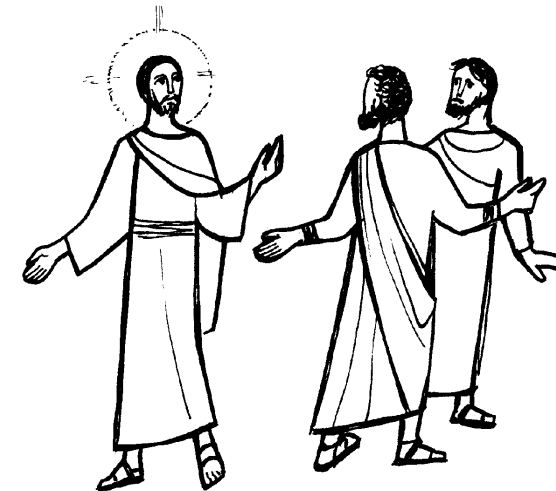
